



Dr. Harrison recommends the following in elderly horses. The reason he recommends these vaccines is because the immune system in an older horse takes more to keep the level of immunity at a rate that will provide adequate protection for the horse.

A standard farm visit for 1 horse is \$50. If there are multiple owners, Dr. Harrison will charge a split call charge fee of \$30 per client, not per horse.
